



New Car Seat Laws

For Nebraska
Effective January 1, 2019



- Children ride **rear-facing** until up to age **two** or until they reach the upper weight or height limit allowed by the car seat's manufacturer.
- All children up to age **eight** must ride correctly secured in a federally-approved child safety seat/belt positioning booster.
- Children under age **eight** must ride in the **back seat**, as long as there is a back seat equipped with a seat belt and is not already occupied by other children under eight years of age.
- Children ages nine to eighteen must ride secured in a seat belt.

For the safety and protection of your child(ren), never place a small child in a seat near an activated air bag!
